KINGSBURY FIREHOUSE AND PUMPER

Our early manufacturing years focused on brightly colored tinplate reproductions from the pre-World War II Lionel® era. It is this manufacturing experience that has allowed us to expand into the tin-plate toy era with our debut product, the 1911 Kingsbury Firehouse and Pumper truck.

The 19 inch long stamped steel firehouse was a staple in the Wilkens-Kinsbury toy line from 1911 to 1930. Automatic doors were controlled by an alarm box, mounted on the right side of the station. When the alarm was sufficiently wound it could be activated by a concealed trigger. The resulting action caused the bell to ring and the two front doors to fly open. The pre-sound Pumper Truck would then roll out with its bell a-ringing!

The Pumper Truck, also formed from stamped steel construction, is mounted on cast iron spoked wheels and was powered by Kingsbury's patented windup spring motor mechanism, making the Pumper Truck one of the first toys to enter the motorized age.

Our reproduction of the Kingsbury Firehouse and Pumper Truck is an exact copy of the original, right down to the windup clockwork mechanisms and paint color. Fully operational, the set makes a welcome addition to any toy collector of pre-war stamped steel and tinplate toys. What's more, the Firehouse's size puts it completely at home with pre-war Lionel standard gauge trains and accessories as well.
